

Submission of Corrections Guidelines

1. You may submit corrections to me for any problem or problems which you wish to have graded for additional credit.
2. The corrections should be submitted on separate paper.
3. If your in-class exam was Exam III-A, then
the corrections which you submit to me should come from Exam III-A-Makeup.

More specifically, if your in-class exam was Exam III-A and if

your last name falls between A-F, then the corrections which you submit to me should come from Exam III-A (A-F)

your last name falls between G-R, then the corrections which you submit to me should come from Exam III-A (G-R)

your last name falls between S-Z, then the corrections which you submit to me should come from Exam III-A (S-Z)

If your in-class exam was Exam III-B, then
the corrections which you submit to me should come from Exam III-B-Makeup.

More specifically, if your in-class exam was Exam III-B and if

your last name falls between A-F, then the corrections which you submit to me should come from Exam III-B (A-F)

your last name falls between G-R, then the corrections which you submit to me should come from Exam III-B (G-R)

your last name falls between S-Z, then the corrections which you submit to me should come from Exam III-B (S-Z)

4. If you submit corrections for problems: 1,2 or 3 then
the corrections must rework the entire problem (from the makeup exam).

If you submit corrections for problem: 4 then
the corrections may be just for part or parts of the problem (A, B, C, D or E). The corrections should be for the entire part or parts (from the makeup exam).
5. The corrections are worth up to 75% of the missed credit.
6. The corrections are due back to me by **Wednesday, Apr 11 at 5:00 pm** (in my mailbox in MA 201).
7. You do not need to return the original exam to me.
